



Women in Culinary Apprenticeship Scholarship (WIA) Guidelines and Eligibility

Thank you for your interest in applying for the Women in Culinary Apprenticeship Scholarship. We look forward to reviewing your application and will do our best to award as many scholarships as possible during the quarterly award cycle. To qualify for the scholarship, please read this document in its entirety. If you feel you are eligible to apply, follow the link and complete the application form.

There is a limited pool of funds available, and the scholarship committee will determine the level of award available for each application submitted.

Application must be received by the concierge department 15 days prior to the next quarter start. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Full Scholarship Eligibility and Details:

- WIA Scholarship application is available to prospective students that have:
 - Successfully completed the school application.
 - Successfully provided all enrollment documentation
 - Received DIG offer of admission
 - Paid the commitment deposit.
- WIA Scholarship funds:
 - Full scholarship can cover DIG tuition up to 48 credits.
 - Are dispersed quarterly at the start of the quarter.
 - Are not available as cash disbursements.
 - Are not available to cover DIG fees.
- WIA Application
 - Applicant must submit a 500-word personal essay explaining the reasons why the WIA Scholarship is important to them and if awarded, how it will impact their career goals and community service.
- WIA Scholarship is a closed scholarship available to all females or those who identify as female.
- WIA Scholarship recipients, to remain scholarship eligible during the award cycle, must maintain a full-time course load and persist as a student in good standing with a CGPA of 2.5 or higher.



Partial Scholarship Eligibility and Details:

- WIA Partial Scholarship follows the same guidelines as the Full Scholarship
- WIA Scholarship application is available to current students fully enrolled.
 - Prospective students may be eligible if full scholarship is not awarded (see above).
- Students must have completed 1 full quarter (12 credits) of education and be a student in good academic standing with a CGPA of 2.5 or above.
- WIA Application:
 - Applicant must submit a 500-word personal essay explaining the reasons why the WIA Scholarship is important to them and if awarded, how it will impact their career goals and community service.
- Award amounts will be based on academic merit and tuition proposal that is on file.
- WIA Scholarship is a closed scholarship available to all females or those who identify as female.
- WIA Scholarship recipients, to remain scholarship eligible during the award cycle, must maintain a full-time course load and persist as a student in good standing with a CGPA of 2.5 or higher.
